Pikes Peak Reservoir - Alice Prince

Late in 2016 the City of Bellevue Utilities Dept. asked representatives of several Bridle Trails organizations and neighborhoods to meet and discuss replacing the Pikes Peak Reservoir and Pump Station in Bridle Trails State Park.

Jay Hummel of Bellevue Utilities explained the need to replace the current out of date reservoir and pump station in order to provide up to date water service reliability and fire protection to residents of the Bridle Trails community.

The Community Advisory Group shared the concerns of the people they represented regarding the construction involved in the project and helped evaluate the proposed improvements and construction plans.

After several meetings, a live open house, and an on-line open house, the 4 major alternative construction plans were narrowed down to 1 preferred plan which the Utilities group would present to the Capital Improvement Project (CIP) Cabinet. BœThe one chosen to take forward was "a circular prestressed concrete reservoir" with the pump station to be offsite at Cherry Crest.

The preliminary Project Schedule for all of this is; Review and finalize evaluations - 2017, Design and Permitting – late 2017 through mid 2018, Bidding and Contract Award - late 2018 through early 2019, and Construction – early 2019 through mid to late 2020.
